

## S.L.I.M.E. ACADEMY HOW TO MAKE SLIME

How to make slime with contact solution	
Materials	<ul> <li>1 Bottle of Elmer's Glue (white school glue)</li> <li>1/2 teaspoon Baking Soda</li> <li>1½ TBSP of Contact Lens Solution</li> <li>1 TBSP of water         <ul> <li>Optional - Add 2 TBSP to up to 1/2 CUP of water if you'd like a stretchier slime.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Optional - Add in glitter or food coloring if desired</li> </ul>
Instructions	<ol> <li>Get a bowl to mix your slime ingredients in.</li> <li>Pour your entire 6 oz Elmer's Glitter glue into the bowl.</li> <li>Add your baking soda and mix in thoroughly. Also add 1 TBSP or more (up to 1/2 cup) of water here if you want a stretchier slime.</li> <li>Slowly add in your contact lens solution (reminder: your contact lens solution should contain boric acid or your slime will not form). Add it in slowly and mix if possible so that you can adjust and ensure you do not add too much. You may not need the full amount so take this step slowly. (add food coloring or glitter if desired)</li> <li>Now mix until your slime forms and begins to harden. Take it out and knead, knead, knead. You may be surprised how much you need to knead to really make the slime form. If it's not the desirable consistency keep kneading. If you find it to still be too sticky, add a little bit of lotion or baby oil to your hands.</li> </ol>

How to make slime with laundry detergent	
Materials	<ul> <li>½ cup of Elmer's Glue (white school glue)</li> <li>½ cup water</li> <li>¾ cup liquid laundry detergent</li> <li>Optional - Add in glitter or food coloring if desired</li> </ul>
Instructions	<ol> <li>Mix together equal amounts of white school glue and water. Pour 1/2 cup (120 milliliters) of water into a bowl. Next, stir in 1/2 cup (120 milliliters) of white school glue. Make sure that you get all of the glue out of the measuring cup. Use a fork, spoon, or mini rubber spatula to get it all out</li> <li>Stir in 1/4 cup (60 milliliters) of liquid laundry detergent with a fork. As you stir the laundry detergent into the glue, the mixture will begin to stick together. Keep stirring until you have a glob</li> <li>Knead the slime with your hands for 1 to 2 minutes. If the bowl is too small for this, dump the slime onto a smooth counter, and knead it there. The more you knead the slime, the firmer and less watery it will become. This will take about 1 to 2 minutes</li> </ol>
